#### ARTICLE VIII OFFICERS

Section 1. The Officers of the corporation shall be a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other Officers as may be provided by the By-Laws.

Section 2. The names of the persons who are to serve as Officers of the corporation until their successors are elected and qualified are:

Section 3. The Officers shall be elected at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors as provided by the By-Laws.

#### ARTICLE IX BY-LAWS

Section 1. The Board of Directors of this corporation may provide such By-Laws for the conduct of its business and the carrying out of its purposes as they may deem necessary from time to time.

Section 2. Upon proper notice the By-Laws may be amended, altered or rescinded by a majority vote of the members of the Board of Directors present at any regular meeting or any special meeting called for that purpose.

#### ARTICLE X AMENDMENTS

Section 1. These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a special meeting of the membership called for that purpose by a sixty percent (60%) vote of those present.

Section 2. Amendments may also be made at a regular meeting of the membership upon notice given as provided by the By-Laws of intention to submit such amendments for consideration.

ARTICLE XI DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS  
UPON DISSOLUTION

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any profits, dividends, from the undertaking of this corporation and upon dissolution of this organization all of its assets remaining after the payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal Government, or a State or local Government, for public purposes, and none of the assets will be distributed to any member, officer or trustee of this corporation.

ARTICLE XII POLITICAL ACTIVITY

None of the funds or property of this corporation shall ever be used in an effort to influence legislation or to support or attempt to defeat any candidate for public office.
